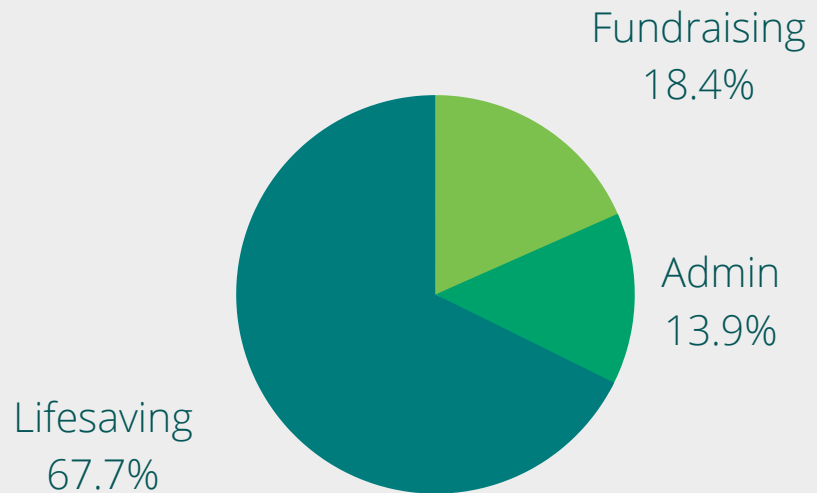


2021 IMPACT

The Big Dig in May 2021 was HPA!'s first introduction to the world of fundraising events, and boy did we start off with a bang! We had about 150 attendees, over 20 vendors, raised \$10,000, and only grew from there!

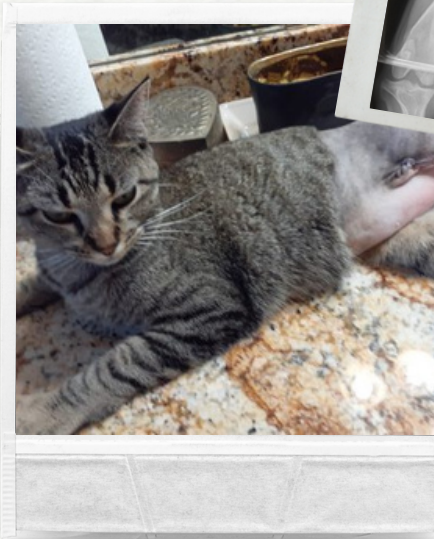
2021 brought unanticipated challenges for HPA! after a year of suspended public animal services took its toll on our community. We began to find out just how quickly the homeless animal population could climb and started seeing the effects "back to work" initiatives had on the previous success of 2020 adoptions.



In October, Barktoberfest saw almost 800 people and their pups join in on the fun, along with about 40 vendors, and raised \$25,000! It really put into perspective the potential that HPA! has in growing our reach and impact with our community's support!



Not only did HPA! host it's first major events in 2021, but we also participated in many other incredible offsite events throughout the year! From joining Subaru at the Houston Auto Show, to hosting adoptions at Kroger locations, throwing puppy parties, and more, HPA! has increased its involvement within our community and continues to be committed to spreading the word on how people can get involved to help save lives.



This past year proved to us yet again that when the going gets tough and there are animals in need, our supporters always show up to help. As more animals were left behind due to Houston's ongoing homeless animal crisis, we saw multiple pups and kitties enter our care needing more help on their healing journey than most, and every time we shared their stories our community came together to give them the support they needed! Gwen, Denali, Jimmy, Twix, and so many more would not be where they are today without our supporters!

HPA! also hosted a volunteer appreciation dinner to thank our incredible community of volunteers, including those who constantly help care for our hundreds of kitties!
